

National Yang Ming Chiao Tung University Regulations Governing the Establishment of the Innovative Creative Technology Co-Working Space Advisory Committee

Approved at the 110th Academic Year 3rd Academic Affairs Meeting on March 4, 2022

- Article 1. National Yang Ming Chiao Tung University (hereinafter referred to as “NYCU”) hereby formulates the Regulations Governing the Establishment of the Innovative Creative Technology Co-Working Space Advisory Committee (hereinafter referred to as the “Regulations”) to integrate the interdisciplinary teachers and teaching resources of NYCU, improve NYCU students’ basic and professional abilities in implementation and upgrade their employment and academic competitiveness.
- Article 2. The Dean of Academic Affairs holds the position as the convener of the Innovative Creative Technology Co-Working Space (“ICT”) Advisory Committee (hereinafter referred to as the “Committee”), and the Associate Dean of Academic Affairs, Associate Dean of General Affairs and Director of the ICT serve as the ex officio members of the Committee. Meanwhile, the convener recommends 5~7 teachers who are assistant professors or above from professional fields to form the Committee. The Committee members shall hold the term of office for two years and without pay, but may hold a new term of office if reappointed.
- Article 3. The Committee shall perform the following functions and operations:
1. Provide the ICT with advice and recommendations on promotion of interdisciplinary teaching and hands-on skill training.
 2. Review the application for establishment, and abolishment, of the ICT professional field taskforce.
 3. Coordinate, integrate and improve ICT courses, space and equipment matters.
 4. Provide any other advice on interdisciplinary hands-on teaching.
- Article 4. The Committee meeting shall be convened by the ICT once per semester. A special meeting may be convened whenever necessary.
- Article 5. The Regulations shall be enforced upon approval by the Academic Affairs meeting. The same shall apply to any amendments hereto.
